### Overview

Proposes to allow the Duluth school board to reduce the number of at-large board members elected at the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter.  
Reduces from 9 to 7 the total number of Duluth school board members.

### Section

**1 At-large school board members; independent school district No. 709, Duluth.** (a) Allows the Duluth school board to act by resolution to reduce from five to three the number of at-large members on the board elected at the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter.

(b) Declares that if the Duluth school board adopts such a resolution, the number of board members elected at-large for the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter is reduced from three to one.

(c) Allows currently serving and otherwise qualified board members to run for re-election when their terms expire.

Makes this section effective immediately.
