### Overview

This bill requires a study of the availability and cost of insurance for ambulance service providers.

#### Section

- 1 Ambulance service liability insurance study.** Requires the commissioner of commerce to study the availability and cost of ambulance vehicle and malpractice insurance. Requires a report to the legislature by January 10, 2004, on the study, including recommendations on how to ensure the availability of affordable insurance for ambulance service providers.
