## **Overview**

The commissioner of agriculture registers each type of fertilizer that can be sold or used in Minnesota. House File 258 would prohibit registration for fertilizers that contain more than a specified amount of arsenic.

## **Section**

Registration of fertilizer containing arsenic. The section of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 18C, that deals with the registration of fertilizer products for sale or use in Minnesota is amended by the addition of a subdivision prohibiting the commissioner from registering a fertilizer or fertilizer product that contains more than 500 parts per million of arsenic.
