Overview

The commissioner of agriculture registers each type of fertilizer that can be sold or used in Minnesota. House File 258 would prohibit registration for fertilizers that contain more than a specified amount of arsenic.

Section

- 1 Registration of fertilizer containing arsenic.** The section of Minnesota Statutes, chapter 18C, that deals with the registration of fertilizer products for sale or use in Minnesota is amended by the addition of a subdivision prohibiting the commissioner from registering a fertilizer or fertilizer product that contains more than 500 parts per million of arsenic.
