Noncommercial signs exemption. Amends the law that pre-empts municipal ordinances on the size of signs during the state general election season. Makes the law applicable whether or not a municipality has an ordinance. Provides that in all cases, noncommercial signs of any size can be posted in any number from August 1 to ten days after the state general election.
