Overview

Defines middle school to mean a school with a minimum of two, instead of three grades between grades 5 and 9.

Section

1 **Middle school.** Redefines middle school to mean a school giving an approved course of study in a minimum of two, instead of three consecutive grades between grades 5 and 9.

Makes this section effective for the 2003-2004 school year and later.
