Authorizes fraternal organizations licensed to conduct lawful gambling to spend net gambling profits on utility bills for buildings they own or lease and use as primary headquarters, if the fraternal organization demonstrates to the gambling control board that its membership declined by at least 10 percent during the ten years prior to the year in which the expenditure is made.
