This bill would authorize the Minneapolis city council by ordinance to establish positions in the unclassified service of the city and to provide for terms and conditions of employment for the unclassified positions. The positions established must meet the enumerated criteria and the law would not apply to a department head position appointed under specific authority in the Minneapolis city charter. These positions are largely senior executive-level positions and the people in them would work directly with department heads, the mayor or the city council and serve at the pleasure of the mayor or the council.
