## **Overview**

The bill repeals existing statutes pertaining to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) operating a Minnesota conservation corps for youth and adults ages 15 to 26, and transfers this duty and related assets to an existing nonprofit corporation.

## **Section**

- Minnesota conservation corps. Provides for the transfer of duties, including setting up bylaws, hiring staff and corps members, permitting fees, a preferred bidding process for state contracts, limitations on projects, and providing for audits to the nonprofit Minnesota Conservation Corps.
- **Transfer of assets.** Transfers assets, such as computers, tools, and equipment used by the DNR for conservation corps purposes to the nonprofit corporation.
- **Transfer of funds.** Transfers any funds still in accounts for conservation corps purposes to the nonprofit corporation.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$1,200,000 in each of the next two fiscal years to the nonprofit corporation for conservation corps activities.
- **Repealer.** Repeals existing law in the DNR statutes that pertained to DNR conservation corps purposes.
