Overview

This bill makes changes to the child care center experienced aide section of statute and strikes the June 30, 2003 expiration date.

Section

- 1 Experienced aides; child care centers.** Makes technical changes. Requires centers that use experienced aides to post notification in each classroom that uses an experienced aide. Requires records of experienced aide usage to be kept on-site and given to licensors upon request. Prohibits child care centers from using experienced aides for one year following two experienced aide violations within a one-year period. Allows child care centers to use one experienced aide per every four full-time child care classroom staff. Strikes the June 30, 2003 expiration of this statute.
