Overview

Proposes to allow the Duluth school board to reduce the number of at-large board members elected at the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter. Reduces from 9 to 7 the total number of Duluth school board members.

Section

1 At-large school board members; independent school district No. 709, Duluth. (a) Allows the Duluth school board to act by resolution to reduce from five to three the number of atlarge members on the board elected at the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter.

(b) Declares that if the Duluth school board adopts such a resolution, the number of board members elected at-large for the November 2003 election and each four years thereafter is reduced from three to one.

(c) Allows currently serving and otherwise qualified board members to run for re-election when their terms expire.

Makes this section effective immediately.
