### Overview

Transfers the responsibilities for administering the Indian post secondary scholarship program from the commissioner of children, families and learning to the higher education services office and directs the revisor to make conforming changes in law.

#### Section

- 1**      **Transfer of powers.** Transfers the powers, duties, and obligations of the commissioner of children, families and learning related to the Indian post secondary scholarship program to the higher education services office. Establishes Bemidji as the location for administering the program.
- 2**      **Revisor's instruction.** Directs the revisor to renumber the statutory provision being amended in section 1 and to replace references to the commissioner of children, families and learning with references to the higher education services office.
- 3**      **Effective date.** Makes sections 1 and 2 immediately effective.
