**1 Repealer.** Current law does not allow evidence in a suit for personal injury or property damage resulting from use or operation of a motor vehicle of (1) use or failure to use a seat belt or child restraint system, or (2) installation or failure to install seatbelts or a child restraint system, except in an action for damages involving a defectively designed, manufactured, installed or operating seat belt or child restraint system.

The bill repeals this statute, eliminating restrictions on seat belt evidence.

**Effective date; application.** Immediate. Applies to actions pending on or started on or after the effective date.
