- Four-year contracts required. Provides that contracts between the Emergency Medical Services Regulatory Board and the eight regional emergency medical services systems will be for four-year terms contingent upon appropriation of adequate funds.
- **Two sets of special license plates.** Permits volunteer ambulance attendants to obtain two sets of special license plates for their personal vehicles.
- Claimant agency. Permits any licensed ambulance service to be a claimant agency for purposes of the Revenue Recapture Act. Under that act, a claimant agency may collect debts owed to it by means of set-off against state tax refunds due to the debtor. Currently, only municipal ambulance services participate in this program.
- **Police radio equipment.** Permits ambulance service personnel to equip their vehicles with police frequency radios.
