Adds sports boards to the list of legal forms of lawful (charitable) gambling. Defines "sports board" as a game where players buy a square, line, or other chance on a board with the winner determined by the outcome of a professional sporting event.

Authorizes the gambling control board to adopt rules for sports board games. Limits boards to 25 lines and 100 squares. Limits the maximum prize for a single board to \$500, and the maximum price of a chance to \$10.
