Amends the law that authorizes social dice games on premises licensed for retail sale of alcoholic beverages:

- 4 allows cash prizes of up to \$200 per game (present law limits prizes only to food and beverages)
- 4 allows the licensed establishment to organize the game, as long as individual participants compete against each other and not the establishment and the establishment does not have an interest in the game or participate financially in it
- 4 prohibits a person who organizes the game from having an interest in the outcome or participating financially
