Overview

Removes legislators from membership on the following groups: Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board; Agriculture Education Leadership Council; Agricultural Utilization Research Institute; St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board; Amateur Sports Commission; Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board

Section

1	Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board. Removes two legislators from the
	Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board, and reduces the size of the board from ten
	to eight.
2	Agriculture Education Leadership Council. Removes six legislators from the Agriculture
	Education Leadership Council and reduces the size of the council from 16 to ten.
3	Agriculture Education Leadership Council. Strikes language providing that two
	legislators are co-chairs of the Agriculture Education Leadership Council.
4	Agricultural Utilization Research Institute. Strikes two legislators from the board of
	directors of the Agricultural Utilization Research Institute.
5	St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board. Strikes four legislators from the St. Anthony Falls
	Heritage Board and reduces the size of the board from 22 to 18.
6	Amateur Sports Commission. Provides that specified appointments to the Amateur Sports
	Commission must not be legislators.
7	IRRRB. Strikes ten legislators and two legislative appointees from the Iron Range
	Resources and Rehabilitation Board. Provides that all 13 members of the board will be
	nonlegislators appointed by the Governor.
