Overview

Removes legislators from membership on the following groups: Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board; Agriculture Education Leadership Council; Agricultural Utilization Research Institute; St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board; Amateur Sports Commission; Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board

Section

- 1 Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board.** Removes two legislators from the Capitol Area Architectural and Planning Board, and reduces the size of the board from ten to eight.
- 2 Agriculture Education Leadership Council.** Removes six legislators from the Agriculture Education Leadership Council and reduces the size of the council from 16 to ten.
- 3 Agriculture Education Leadership Council.** Strikes language providing that two legislators are co-chairs of the Agriculture Education Leadership Council.
- 4 Agricultural Utilization Research Institute.** Strikes two legislators from the board of directors of the Agricultural Utilization Research Institute.
- 5 St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board.** Strikes four legislators from the St. Anthony Falls Heritage Board and reduces the size of the board from 22 to 18.
- 6 Amateur Sports Commission.** Provides that specified appointments to the Amateur Sports Commission must not be legislators.
- 7 IRRRB.** Strikes ten legislators and two legislative appointees from the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board. Provides that all 13 members of the board will be nonlegislators appointed by the Governor.
