Under current law, money received for or from the operation of the Aitkin County Long Lake Conservation Training Center goes into a separate fund, other than the county park fund, that is under the control of the secretary-treasurer of the county park commission.

This bill provides that the separate fund will be under the control of the county. The bill also provides that the books and affairs of the conservation training center are subject to examination by the state auditor, without regard to whether the center receives appropriations.
