Overview

This bill limits the licensing fees that local governments may charge sellers of fireworks and prohibits imposing certain other requirements on sellers.

Section

1 **Local fireworks regulation.** Limits a local government's ability to impose an annual licensing fee to a maximum of \$350 for retailers in the business of selling fireworks, or \$100 for other retailers that sell fireworks among other things.

Prohibits local governments from imposing any other fees, restricting or prohibiting the display for sale of authorized fireworks, or requiring additional financial guarantees from those who sell fireworks, such as bonding or insurance.

2 **Effective date.** Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment.
