## Overview

Policies to be established. Allows a school district to include in its student discipline policy a provision to allow the district, in consultation with a student's parent, to assign a student to an area learning center or provide other alternative educational services, consistent with district policy.

Strikes a requirement that the DCFL commissioner actively encourage and assist districts to cooperatively establish alternative educational services to pupils who are dismissed for engaging in dangerous, disruptive or violent behavior.
