Overview

Allows city managers to revoke an election to be excluded from membership in the Public Employees Retirement Association.

Section

- 1 Election.** Under current law a city manager may elect to be excluded from membership in the Public Employees Retirement Association (PERA). The current law specifies the time and manner for electing to be excluded, and states that the decision to be excluded is irrevocable.

This bill allows a city manager to revoke a decision to be excluded from PERA. Revocation must be approved by a resolution of the governing body of the city, and notice of revocation must be filed in writing with PERA. The bill specifies timing for PERA membership to resume prospectively.
