Overview

This bill excludes private, for-profit institutions from participating in the state grant program. Students attending these institutions would be ineligible to receive a state grant.

Section

- Eligible institution. Excludes private for-profit post-secondary institutions from participation in the state grant program. Under current law, any post-secondary educational institution is eligible to participate in the state grant program if the institution has signed an agreement with the Higher Education Services Office.
- **Student.** Excludes students attending for-profit post-secondary institutions from being eligible for a state grant.
- 3 Eligibility for grants. Limits eligibility for a state grant to students who meet the admission requirements at an eligible institution. Section 1 limits eligible institutions to public institutions or private, non profit, post-secondary institutions.
