Provides an exception to the conflict of interest law for township supervisors. Permits a township to enter into a contract even if a supervisor is an employee of the contractor as long as the supervisor had no role in the bid or negotiation process and abstains from voting on any action related to the contract after disclosing the reasons for abstaining from voting.
