Emergency response. If the governor declares by proclamation that a national security emergency exists in all or part of the state, or if the governor declares a peacetime emergency, and if the commissioner of agriculture has probable cause to believe that a food or consumer commodity is likely to be adulterated, the commissioner may embargo a geographic area of the state that is included in the declared emergency. The commissioner must provide notice to the public and those with custody of the food or consumer commodity.
