Overview

Makes supervised competitive high school diving in pools built before January 1, 1987, subject to the swimming and diving rules of the national federation of state high school associations.

Section

1 Supervised competitive high school diving. Allows pools built before January 1, 1987, that satisfy the swimming and diving rules of the national federation of the state high school associations to be used for supervised competitive high school diving provided that appropriate notice is sent to parents and participants.

Applies to schools or districts that provided a high school diving program during the 2000-2001 school year.

Makes this section effective for the 2003-2004 school year and later.
