Overview

Allows resident charter school students to participate in the extracurricular activities of a district on the same basis as the students enrolled in the district's schools.

Section

- Board control of extracurricular activities. (a) Makes all resident students enrolled in a charter school eligible to participate in a district's extracurricular activities on the same basis as public school students enrolled in the district's schools. Requires charter school students interested in participating in the extracurricular activities to meet the academic and student conduct requirements of the charter school.
 - (f) Allows school districts to charge charter schools a proportionate share of the costs of the extracurricular activities not covered by student fees.

Makes this section effective for the 2003-2004 school year and later.
