Designates the bridge on T. H. 23 over the St. Louis river as "Biauswah Bridge" and directs MnDOT to erect signs, subject to the law that requires the cost of the signs to be paid from nonstate sources.

Directs the DNR to name and dedicate the cemetery in Jay Cooke State Park that is on land leased to the Fond du Lac Band of Lake Superior Chippewa by Duluth as "Roussain Cemetery," and directs the department to design and erect signs after consultation with the band.
