Overview

This bill authorizes the state to sell and issue \$750,000 in general obligation bonds to fund a grant to the city of Gaylord for construction of a multicultural and lifelong learning center.

Section

- 1 Appropriation.** Appropriates \$750,000 from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to the city of Gaylord to design, construct, furnish, and equip a multicultural and lifelong learning center. Requires the grant to be matched on a one-to-one basis with money from nonstate sources. Authorizes the state to sell and issue \$750,000 in general obligation bonds to fund the grant to the city of Gaylord.
- 2 Effective date.** Makes section 1 effective the day following final enactment.
