Overview

This bill restores funding for a grant to the Duluth school district that initially had been initially approved by the Legislature during the late 1990s. The original grant amount canceled back to the state after it went unused for a few years. The money is for an addition and improvements to Grant Magnet School. The initial grant was one of several made at that time for youth and community centers.

Section

- 1** **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$1,065,000 from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of education for a grant to the Duluth School District for improvements to Grant Magnet School.
- 2** **Bond sale.** Instructs the commissioner of finance to sell and issued \$1.065 million in state general obligation bonds for the purpose of making the grant in section 1.
- 3** **Effective date.** Makes sections 1 and 2 effective the day following final enactment.
