### Overview

This bill authorizes the state to sell and issue \$3.6 million in general obligation bonds to fund capital improvements at the Perpich Center for Arts Education. The Perpich Center for Arts Education is located in Golden Valley and by statute, may serve up to 310 students in 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> grade in the arts high school. The Perpich Center also serves as a resource center for arts education providing a Professional Development Institute (PDI), a Research, Assessment and Curriculum Division (RAC), and a library.

#### Section

- 1 **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$3.6 million from the state bond proceeds fund to the commissioner of administration for a capital improvement projects at the Perpich Center for Arts Education. Projects include:
  - asset preservation;
  - Beta building demolition;
  - Alpha building renovation; and
  - dormitory renovation.
- 2 **Bond sale.** Requests the commissioner of finance to sell and issue \$3.6 million in state

**Section**

**3** general obligation bonds to fund the capital improvements authorized in section 1.  
**Effective date.** Makes sections 1 and 2 effective the day following final enactment.
