Overview

This bill authorizes retired court commissioners to be appointed or assigned to perform judicial duties in the district court.

Section

1 Retired justices, judges, and commissioners. (a) Authorizes the Chief Justice to assign retired court commissioners to serve as active district court commissioners.

(c) Authorizes the appointment of a retired commissioner who is in good standing and not practicing law to serve as a court commissioner of any court but the Supreme Court or Court of Appeals.
