Requires the Board of Private Detective and Protective Agent Services to create a special protective agent license classification for certain protective agents who control motor traffic on public streets for the purpose of escorting funeral processions and oversized loads. The special classification would be for protective agents who are otherwise qualified for licensure but who do not have a minimum of 6,000 hours experience as an investigator or protective agent. These individuals would be allowed to control traffic to escort funeral processions and oversized loads.
