Overview

In 1991, the Legislature authorized each school district to levy up to \$300,000 for disability access projects. The levy authority extended for eight years, once a district started levying for projects. Most large school districts used the full amount of this authority in the first few years. However, a number of school districts did not use the full \$300,000 prior to the expiration of the eight-year timeline.

According to Department of Education records, Independent School District No. 595, East Grand Forks, had \$229,000 of authority remaining in 1999 when its eight-year authority expired.

This bill authorizes Independent School District No. 595, East Grand Forks, to levy its remaining disabled access levy authority over the next five years.
