## **Overview**

Proposes a constitutional amendment to provide staggered terms of office for Senators.

## **Section**

- Constitutional amendment. Provides that after each new legislative redistricting, Senators elected from odd-numbered districts will be elected for two-year terms. The effect of this is that half of the Senate would be up for election at each state general election.
- **Question.** To be submitted at the 2006 general election. Makes the new system take effect at 2010 election.
