Overview

The Minnesota Partnership For Biotechnology And Medical Genomics is a collaborative venture between the University of Minnesota and the Mayo Clinic that seeks, among other things, to position Minnesota as a world leader in biotechnology and medical genomics, create a new industry, and expand Minnesota's tax base. This bill would appropriate \$15,000,000 to the partnership each year for five years, beginning in fiscal year 2006.

Section

- **Appropriation.** Appropriates \$15,000,000 from the general fund to the commissioner of employment and economic development for operating expenses for the joint partnership between the University of Minnesota and the Mayo Clinic for research in biotechnology and medical genomics.
 - Appropriates this amount each year for five years, beginning in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006.
 - Makes each appropriation available until expended.
