### Overview

This bill appropriates money to build a new 150-bed high security segregation unit at the Minnesota Correctional Facility in Stillwater. The construction plans include remodeling the Discipline Unit and the Psychology/Psychiatry Unit, demolishing the former Health Services Building, and removing dividing walls.

#### Section

- 1**      **Appropriation** . Appropriates \$20,848,000 to design, construct, furnish, and equip a new 150-bed high security segregation unit for the Minnesota Correctional Facility in Stillwater.
- 2**      **Bond Sale.** Authorizes the sale of state bonds to provide the money appropriated in section 1.
- 3**      **Effective date.** Sections 1 and 2 are effective the day following final enactment.
