### Section

- 1** **Revisor instruction.** Requires the Revisor of Statutes to change terms in Minnesota Statutes referring to people with certain disabilities.
- 2** **Rules.** Requires the Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities, in consultation with the departments of Administration and Human Services, to review Minnesota Rules and provide the Revisor of Statutes a list of rules containing outdated language specified in section 1 and the appropriate terminology changes that must be made in each of the rules. Requires the Revisor of Statutes to make appropriate changes in Minnesota Rules.
- 3** **State agencies.** Provides that state agencies shall use terminology changes specified in section 1 when printed materials and signage are replaced. Specifies that state agencies do not have to replace existing materials and signage to comply with sections 1 and 2. Specifies that language changes made according to sections 1 and 2 do not expand or exclude eligibility to services.
