This bill permits a statutory or home rule charter city, county or town to appoint a person between 16 and 21 years of age to any advisory board. It limits the number of appointees between 16 and 21 to one person unless there are open positions and no one else is interested and qualified. Finally, it states that the proposed new law does not apply to appointments to youth advisory boards.
