Overview

This bill instructs the Revisor to publish a table in Minnesota Statutes that cross-references laws imposing collateral sanctions in a manner that provides quick access to users.

Section

- 1 Collateral Sanctions Cross-References; Publishing a Table.
 - **Subd. 1. Definition.** Defines "collateral sanction" as a legal penalty, disability, or disadvantage that is imposed on a person upon conviction of a crime. A collateral sanction is <u>not</u> a direct consequence of a crime (*e.g.*, fine, restitution, or incarceration) or a requirement imposed by the sentencing court or official (*e.g.*, DNA analysis, fingerprinting, or assessment).
 - **Subd. 2. Revisor Instruction.** Instructs the Revisor to publish a table in the Minnesota Statutes that contains cross-references to Minnesota laws that impose collateral sanctions, including sanctions relating to employment, driving, public safety, property rights, and civil rights.
 - **Subd. 3. Cautionary Language.** Requires the Revisor to use appropriate cautionary language that notifies users that the cross-reference table is for reference only and

does not have any substantive legal effect.

Subd. 4. Consultation with Legislators and Legislative Staff. States that the Revisor shall consult with legislators and legislative staff to identify collateral sanctions.
