This bill raises the required age, from four to eight, up to which children must be transported using a child passenger restraint system. Under current law, violation of this provision is a petty misdemeanor with a fine of up to \$50, which can be waived or reduced if the vehicle operator shows that a passenger restraint system was purchased within 14 days of the violation.

The bill is effective August 1, 2007.
