Overview

Group Residential Housing (GRH) is a state-funded income supplement program that pays for room-and-board costs for low-income adults who have been placed in a licensed or registered setting with which a county human service agency has negotiated a monthly rate. This bill allows for additional GRH beds and increases the GRH supplementary rate for certain facilities.

Section

- 1** **Moratorium on the development of group residential housing beds.** Amends § 256I.04, subd. 3. Allows for an additional two GRH beds for a specified facility located in Hennepin County that provides services for recovering and chemically dependent men.
- 2** **Supplementary rate for certain facilities serving chemically dependent males.** Amends § 256I.05, by adding subd. 1h. Beginning July 1, 2007, requires Ramsey County to negotiate a supplementary rate in addition to the maximum GRH rate, not to exceed \$700 per month, including any inflationary adjustments, for a specified GRH provider located in Ramsey County that serves recovering and chemically dependent males and provides 24-hour-a-day supervision.
