Overview

This bill allows an applicant for a dental license, who graduated from a foreign dental college to be disqualified from examination by the board.

Section

- 1 Dentists.** Amends § 150A.06, subd. 1. Removes the requirement that the board determine whether the training received by a foreign-trained applicant meets or exceeds that provided by accredited dental colleges.
- 2 Effective Date.** Gives this provision an immediate effective date.
