- County certification of persons providing adult foster care to related persons. Amends § 256B.0919, subdivision 3.
 - Provides that a person who provides adult foster care to an individual 18 and older, who meets specific requirements, may be certified to provide adult foster care and be eligible for reimbursement for providing care. This changes the age of the adult for whom foster care is provided from age 65 or older to age 18 or older.
 - Deletes the language that states reimbursement may be provided if the person providing care would suffer financial hardship, such as substantial reduction of income, to care for the individual.
