Provides for the income threshold at which the K-12 education credit begins to phase out to be adjusted annually for inflation. Under current law the threshold is fixed at \$33,500; the credit is fully phased out when income reaches \$37,500 for families with one or two children in grades K-12, and increases by an additional \$2,000 for each additional child in grades K-12 (i.e., to \$39,500 for three children, to \$41,500 for four children, and so on).
