### Section

- 1 Termination of Jurisdiction.** Eliminates the mandate that a court's jurisdiction can not extend past the 18<sup>th</sup> birthday of a habitual truant. By eliminating this requirement, the court's jurisdiction would be consistent with the rule in other child protection cases: If found to be within the best interest of the habitual truant, court jurisdiction over the matter continues until the truant's 19<sup>th</sup> birthday.
