Overview

This bill allows small brewers and brewpubs to sell 750 milliliter bottles, and allows brewers to provide small samples of product during tours.

Section

- Interest in other business. This section allows small brewers (under 3,500 barrels per year) and brewpubs to sell at off-sale a 750 milliliter bottle. Currently, they are limited to growlers, which are 64 ounce containers.
- 2 Malt Liquor Samples authorized. Allows brewers to provide samples of their own products to persons touring the brewery in quantities less than 100 milliliters per variety per person.
