Overview

- Subdivision 1. Commission Established. Establishes the Minnesota Commission on Minnesota Ethnic Heritage to recognize the state's ethnic diversity and assist in fostering understanding and appreciation of ethnic and cultural diversity.
 - **Subd. 2. Membership.** Specifies that the commission is to be comprised of 20 members as follows: four members of the legislature, one each from the minority and majority caucuses in the house and senate; and 16 members of the public appointed by the governor in consultation with state ethnic organizations. Appointed members would serve two-year terms.
 - **Subd. 3. Duties.** Specifies the duties of the commission to include: developing programs and proposals to encourage ethnic identity, preserve ethnic heritage, and promote public education about the state's heritage and cultural history; make recommendations to the legislature and governor to foster the understanding and appreciation of cultural diversity in the state; and maintain association with ethnic, cultural and minority groups to determine community needs.
 - **Subd. 4. Implementation.** Directs the Legislative Coordinating Commission to staff the commission and to consult with the legislature and governor in assisting with the duties of the commission.
- **Appropriation.** Appropriates an unspecified amount of general fund money in fiscal year 2008 to finance the commission.
- 3 **Effective Date.** Specifies that the bill is effective the day following final enactment.
