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Subject: Compensation for Government Shutdown

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Section

Compensation for government shutdown. Requires the Commissioner of Employee Relations to determine the number of hours a state employee was prevented from working due to the partial government shutdown in July 2005. Requires the employee's vacation bank to be credited with this number of hours. Provides that notwithstanding any law or policy to the contrary, an employee may choose to be paid in cash for these hours, rather than having them credited to the employee's vacation bank.

Provides that if an employee has been credited with partial compensation for hours not worked due to the government shutdown, the compensation already provided must be subtracted from compensation that otherwise would be due under this section.
