## Overview

Minnesota's school finance system supports certain ongoing telecommunications activities for school districts and regional library systems.

The school district funding is provided through a formula that reimburses a portion of each district's costs once those costs exceed \$15 per pupil unit. The overall appropriation for the program is capped so that the district aid amounts are prorated to match that cap.

For the 2006-07 biennium, the legislature appropriated about \$7.5 million for school district telecommunications/Internet access aid and \$2.5 million for regional library telecommunications aid. This bill roughly doubles the regional library telecommunications aid to \$2.3 million per year and more than doubles the school district telecommunications aid to \$8.75 million per year.
